



Privacy Statement

Your privacy is important to FIG. Our goal is to treat the personal information you furnish to FIG with the utmost respect and in accordance with this Privacy Policy. We request that you carefully read this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use before using the FIG website. Please note that by visiting, viewing or using the FIG website in any manner whatsoever you are agreeing to the terms set forth in this Privacy Policy, as well as the Terms of Use for the FIG website.

1. Anonymous browsing. You can visit the FIG website on the internet without telling FIG who you are or revealing any information about yourself including, but not limited to, your e-mail address. In this case, our web servers merely collect the name of the domain you used to access the Internet (i.e., aol.com) and the website you came from and subsequently visited after the FIG website. This information may be used by FIG, and/or our business partners, to measure general information such as the number of visits, average time spent, page views, and other statistics about visitors to the FIG website. FIG may also use this data to monitor its website performance and to make the website easier and more convenient to use.

2. Personal information collection. There are times when FIG may ask you for information about yourself to assist us in meeting your various needs, including, without limitation:

- Providing you with requested products or services;
- Servicing your account;
- Improving our services; and
- Developing and/or informing you of additional products or services that may be of interest.

In these cases, your browsing on the FIG website will no longer be anonymous. To provide the aforementioned services, FIG may need to ask you to provide, among other things, personal information such as your name, social security number, physical address, zip code, e-mail address and/or phone number. Please note that FIG does not knowingly solicit information from children and does not knowingly market our products or services to children.

3. Cookies. If you are browsing on the FIG website, or otherwise on the Internet, a cookie is used to help generally measure the number of visits, average time spent, page views and other statistics relating to a website. Said cookie by itself does not reveal to FIG your e-mail address or any other personal information. However, if you decide to register with FIG online we may collect additional information to provide offerings or content tailored to your individual needs.

In this case, FIG uses cookies to recognize you on subsequent visits to the FIG website and make your online experience on FIG's website more convenient. Cookies are small pieces of data stored by your internet browser on your computer's hard drive. Cookies cannot be used to collect data from your hard drive, obtain your e-mail address or other personal-identifying information about you. Please note that you may set your internet browser to notify you when you receive a cookie or to prevent sending cookies. However, by not accepting cookies, you may limit the functionality of the FIG website.

4. Sharing information and consumer choice. When you provide information to FIG we may share your information with our affiliated companies and third-parties for the purpose of fulfilling your requests as well as offering other services that may be of interest to you. However, notwithstanding, the sharing of additional information to any third-party shall not occur unless permitted by you or requested by law. FIG may also aggregate statistics that we gather about our customers, sales, traffic patterns, and services and provide these statistics to third-parties; however, when we do, these statistics will not include any personal information that identifies you or other individuals visiting the FIG website.

5. Information security and protection. FIG takes reasonable technical and organizational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information. FIG uses encryption and authentication tools to protect your personal information and, therefore, information you provide to FIG through our website is secure. FIG employees with access to your information are instructed to use said information only in adherence with the principles set forth in this Privacy Policy and the laws applicable to each specific business and FIG employees who misuse customer information are subject to disciplinary action.
